

History

TTPWS had its beginning in 1959 as the Christian Play School to provide children with a group education experience since there was no public Kindergarten at the time. In 1961, the name was changed to the Temple Terrace Presbyterian Weekday School and included nursery school for three- and four-year-olds as well as a Kindergarten program. In 1984, the School Age Program began with after school pick-up from local schools of a few of our child care children. In 1994, the kindergarten was dropped and the two-year-old program was started. TTPWS attained national accreditation in 1996, and started our VPK program in 2007. Today we serve 130 children in all of these programs.
